July 7th – Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, we hear about the unbelief of many of Jesus' neighbors.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: How strong is your faith? Do you believe Jesus can help you in your daily struggles or do you seek help and comfort from other sources? Turn to Jesus and trust in Him. Build a foundation of trust in Jesus in your life.

July 14th – Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus commissions his disciples to go forth and preach repentance.
