August 4th – Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: As we continue to hear from the Bread of Life discourses, meditate on the Eucharist and pray for those who do not believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: Jesus wants us to come to Him with all our issues, concerns and gratitude. Find time this week to go to Eucharistic Adoration and gaze upon the Lord.
